Christ the King

Daniel 7:9-10, 13-14

⁹ As I watched, thrones were set in place,
and an Ancient One took his throne; his clothing was white as snow,
and the hair of his head like pure wool; his throne was fiery flames,
and its wheels were burning fire.

¹⁰ A stream of fire issued and flowed out from his presence.
A thousand thousand served him,
and ten thousand times ten thousand stood attending him.
The court sat in judgement, and the books were opened.

¹³ As I watched in the night visions, I saw one like a human being
coming with the clouds of heaven.

And he came to the Ancient One and was presented before him.
